Mayor Don Schwenker called the regular session of the Maquoketa City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. with five members present via Zoom Chat.

Motion by Barker, seconded by Kean approving the consent agenda consisting of the agenda, December 21st council meeting minutes, and bills. Motion Carried: 5-0

Audience member Richard Stimmel stated he would like to make a suggestion to the Council with the recent snow and ice, the suggestion is that the City look into a better system to let citizens know when there is a snow emergency. Motion by Collister, seconded by Lyon approving Resolution No. 2021-01, entitled, "Resolution regarding the collection of payment for City costs to abate nuisances and enforce ordinances." Motion Carried 5-0

Gerald Smith stated the Platt Street project is in the final stages of completing paperwork with Tschiggfrie and the IDOT. There are some snags, but they are working through them.

Dan Holm stated he would like the public to think twice about wearing a mask and COVID-19 is really painful to go through and hard to witness someone dying from it.
