Mayor Schwenker opened the Public Hearing On The CDBG Homebuyer Assistance Application.

Mark Schneider stated there are questions that need to be addressed in the public hearing. The proposed Homebuyers assistance program would be for the remaining five Bear River Cottages. The ECIA staff have recognized that many of the potential buyers are having a hard time securing funds to cover closing costs, down payments and other financial rates. The funds will come from the CDBG funds in its entirety of \$103,400.00 with no local match. The applications will be submitted next Friday of \$103,400.00; the potential buyers must meet the guidelines of the CDBG. There will be plans to displacement for homebuyers, they don't anticipate any displacement. The funds will be distributed to closing costs up to \$3,500, inspection costs of up to \$300 and down payments could be up to half of the lending requirements.
