MAQUOKETA CITY COUNCIL MEETING Monday, November 21, 2022

Mayor Messerli called the regular session of the Maquoketa City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. with six members present:

Present: Simonson, Rickerl, Lyon, Collister, Good, Holm Absent: Kuhlman

Motion by Collister, seconded by Holm approving the agenda. Motion Carried 6-0

Motion by Good, seconded by Rickerl approving the consent agenda consisting of the November 7th minutes, bills payable through November 21st in the amount of \$783,597.35 and October Financial reports.

Motion Carried 6-0

Discussion was held regarding Origin Design contract amendment for Platt Street in the amount of \$89,409. Boldt reported this would allow the City to reach the end of the construction season with engineering and the City could consider alternatives for the remaining work next year. He stated he feels the City is perfectly capable of handling the remaining work next fall with a little help on the paperwork.

Boldt confirmed that the additional expenses can go on the loans the City already have rather than coming out of the General Fund or RUT.

Simonson questioned how much of this additional work was just missed. He understands that the underground work is different but the retaining walls seem to be something that should have been known ahead of time.

Collister stated the City had a large increase several months ago and said that some of these items should have been included in that addendum. He questioned how the elevation issues were not caught sooner.

Andy Goedken of Origin Design agreed but stated they were not aware of all of the items back in June.

Boldt reported that the IDOT set the original project at 240 days and the Contractor knew this would be a problem. He stated there will be one more large change order to bring before Council.
