

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Tuesday, June 1, 2021

Mayor Schwenker called the special session of the Maquoketa City Council to order at 2:07 p.m. with four members present.

Present: Lyon, Collister, Kuhlman, Holm Absent: Woodward, Good

Motion by Collister, seconded by Holm approving the agenda. All Ayes

Mayor Schwenker opened the public hearing regarding the FY 20/21 budget amendment. There were no written or verbal comments. Motion by Lyon, seconded by Collister closing the public hearing. Carried 4-0

Motion by Lyon, seconded by Holm approving Resolution No. 2021-44, entitled, "Resolution Approving FY 20/21 Budget Amendment." Motion Carried 4-0

Discussion was held regarding a proposed change order for detour signage for the Platt Street project. Schwenker stated the City is trying to prove this was asked for previously so that it will be reimbursed by the IDOT.

Collister stated he does not want to see a bunch of change orders presented to the Council because things were missed.

Motion by Lyon, seconded by Holm approving Change Order #4 for detour updates for the Platt Street Project pending IDOT approval. Motion Carried 4-0

Smith reported that the boil advisory had been lifted.
