

HORSESHOE POND PARK CAMPGROUND RULES

- 1.) Campers must register and make payment within 1 hour of arrival.
- 2.) RV sites cost \$20/per night, or \$126/per week.
- 3.) A permit must be posted on the individual campsite marking post.
- 4.) All registered campsites shall contain a camping unit overnight.
- 5.) Camping will be permitted only in designated sites (pads) only.
- 6.) No parking on grass.
- 7.) No tent camping on grass. All tents must be on the gravel pads.
- 8.) Quiet hours are from 10:30 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. (Please have respect for other campers.)
- 9.) Unlawful conduct will not be tolerated.
- 10.) No camping unit can remain in the same campsite for longer than 14 consecutive days.
- 11.) Fires are only allowed in designated fire pits.
- 12.) Each campsite will be permitted only one picnic table.
- 13.) Speed limit is 5 MPH throughout the campground.
- 14.) All pets must be on a leash at all times.
- 15.) Place all garbage in dumpsters or trash receptacles provided.
- 16.) Possession of all firearms is prohibited.
- 17.) Cutting or gathering of live trees and/or branches is prohibited.
- 18.) All visitors must vacate campground on or before 10:30 p.m.
- 19.) One family or 4 adults per campsite.
- 20.) Two vehicles permitted per campsite.
- 21.) All abandoned property will be seized (including camping equipment and camping units) if property is left behind or due to nonpayment.
- 22.) Seized property must be claimed within 14 calendar days. If not, the City has the right to sell or dispose of it.
